

## "Lucky the Leprechaun!"

Paint this little fellow with or without the cheek line He looks a bit younger without it, and a bit older with it. :)

<u>PALETTE</u> - Deco Art Americana Acrylics: Bleached Sand, Lamp Black, Hauser Light Green, <u>Plantation Pine</u>, Raspberry, Burgundy Wine, Spicy Mustard, Dusty Rose, Burnt Orange, Burnt Sienna, Royal Purple, Turquoise Blue. (*Opt: DA Glamour Dust Glitter Paint: Sizzling Red, Limeade, Emerald, Purple Passion, Tiger Orange, Turquoise Sparkle*).

BRUSHES - Jo Sonja Sure Touch: Flats 10, 8; Oval Dry (ODB) 6; Filberts 6; Rounds 1, Liners 18/0; LC Maxine Mop 1/2; Stylus.

SURFACE: 012-22, Leprechaun Pin, Valhalla Laser (541) 860-5551; www.valhallalaser.com;

<u>INSTRUCTIONS: 1-Prep:</u> Seal if desired (*I don't when using our etched MDF surface*).

- 2-Initial BASECOAT: Fill in the face with Dusty Rose; the beard has a medium wash of Burnt Sienna. The hat (entirely) is filled in with Lamp Black; the 4-leaf clover is based in Hauser Light Green, tip in Bleached Sand and brush blend; apply the pattern when dry.
- <u>3-HAT STRIPES</u>: The rainbow stripes are based in the given color, but all are tipped into Bleached Sand and brush blended (rough blend, casual! no stress...). Yellow stripe: Spicy Mustard; orange stripe: Burnt Orange; red stripe: Burgundy Wine; purple stripe: Royal Purple; blue stripe: Turquoise Blue; green stripe: Hauser Light Green. When dry, shade around the clover with Lamp Black (over the stripes, softly!).
- <u>4-HAT:</u> Line through the open areas with a brush blend of Lamp Black + Bleached Sand (makes a grey). Float the highlights with Bleached Sand (soft!).
- 5- 4 Leaf CLOVER: Shade the clover with Plantation Pine; highlight with a brush blend of Hauser Light Green + Bleached Sand; further brighten with Bleached Sand. Tint on the right side with a float of Turquoise Blue, float on the bottom petals with Burnt Orange (pretty!). The vein lines & stem and are stroked on using Hauser Light Green tipped in Bleached Sand.
- 6-FACE: Shade with a brush mix of Dusty Rose + Burnt Sienna; deepen floats with Burnt Sienna, highlight with Bleached Sand. The stylus dot eyes, the mouth lines, lashes and brows are Lamp Black; highlight with Bleached Sand. The nose is filled in with Raspberry; shade with Burgundy Wine, highlight with Bleached Sand. Float Raspberry on the lower lip; scrub cheeks with Raspberry, 6 ODB.
- 7-BEARD and HAIR: Use the 1 round loaded in Burnt Sienna and pull through thin Dusty Rose, stroke the beard and hair. Further refine, by moving to the 18/0 liner and the same colors, gradually increase the lightness by pulling through Bleached Sand. Shade through the beard, under hat and all around edges with soft side-loads of Burnt Sienna.
- <u>FINISHING</u>: Erase any remaining graphite. Varnish as desired. If you would like to add sparkle to the pin; use the DA Glitter Paint! I used Sizzling Red on red stripe; Emerald on the dark areas of the petals; Limeade on the lighter green areas of the petals and on the green stripe; use Purple Passion on the purple stripe; use Tiger Orange on the yellow and orange stripe and through the beard; use Turquoise Blue on the blue stripe.
