TRICK OR TREAT? Candy Pin ~ FREE Design

<u>PALETTE ~ DECOART Americana:</u> Spiced Pumpkin, Watermelon Slice, Burnt Sienna, Lamp Black, Banana Cream, Olive Green. *DA Glamour Dust Glitter Paints: Tiger Orange, Sizzling Red.

<u>JO SONJA Brushes & Misc Tools/Supplies:</u> 8 Oval Dry Brush (ODB); 10/0 liner; 1/2 mop; 1/2 square wash, 10, 4 flat. Stylus, glue, pin back. Surface is available @ Valhalla Laser



*An alternate surface, could be water-color paper, or card stock...

<u>INSTRUCTIONS:</u> *Use the mop brush to soften your floats; use the brush you are most comfortable with to float the color.

- 1.) Base the entire candy piece in Spiced Pumpkin; let dry. Use the 4 flat and Lamp Black to check the side edges of the candy piece. Use a pencil and draw the circle of the candy (or transfer the pattern!).
- 2.) Úse the 1/2 Square Wash loaded in a brush mix of Spiced Pumpkin + Burnt Sienna (side-load the brush first in Spiced Pumpkin, blend on palette and then touch the same corner into Burnt Sienna, blend on the palette in the same spot you initially used to blend the Spiced Pumpkin...you should have a pretty blend of the two colors); float all around the perimeter of the candy circle, and behind the circle on the candy wrapper. (So it would be a back-to back float.) Repeat this a couple times, allowing your floats to dry in between.
- 3.) With a brush mix of Burnt Sienna + Lamp Black, float the depth on the candy wrapper gathering, and on the lower right and upper left of the circle. Further deepen on the gathers with a float of just Lamp Black (lift the brush as you float, to create the separated effect.)

4.) With a side-load of Watermelon Slice, float bright, perky tints on the upper right and lower left areas of the circle shape; and in a couple random areas on the candy wrapper.

5.) Use the 8 ODB and Banana Cream to drybrush scrub highlights in the interior area of the circle of the candy; tip the dirty brush into a touch of Olive Green and add a few scrubs in the center of the circle shape and a couple areas on the wrapper.

6.) Use the 4 flat and Lamp Black to create the wiggly stripe on the candy wrapper; line Watermelon Slice next to it on the inside, and Olive Green on top of the black stripe. Use Lamp Black to line the pleated effect (*emphasizing the candy wrapper gathers*).

7.) The highlights are floated using Banana Cream.

8.) (Apply the pattern for the text of your choice.) Use the liner and Lamp Black to stroke the (Trick Or Treat) lettering. Use the stylus and Lamp Black to add the dots on the letters, and scattered on the circle of the candy. Use Olive Green to dot on the Olive Green line on the candy wrapper.

<u>FINISHING</u>: Use the Glamour Dust Glitter Paint to add a little sparkle to your candy pin (who doesn't love sparkle!). I side-load floated Tiger Orange in the shaded areas; and Sizzling Red to enhance the orange in random areas...fun! Varnish; glue a pin back on....enjoy!
